

ERIEZ KARTS 2018

Expectations of Everyone on Premises:

1. Conduct yourself at all times in the spirit of good racing. Do not approach others in a demeaning manner. Do not raise your voices at other fans, drivers, crews or officials. Do not approach the racetrack at any time, unless given the ok by a track official. Verbal &/or Physical abuse to any official, employee, volunteer, competitor or fan is subject to removal of the premises.
2. Sportsmanship – we expect everyone to show good sportsmanship. Go-Karting is the first racing experience MANY drivers get, including mostly minors. Set a good example on how to act for all the minors watching our behaviors. They learn what they see and so we must send the RIGHT message.
3. NO Alcohol consumption during the race program. No Tolerance, No Excuses.
4. Please do not bring in any glass containers. Glass breaks and is unsafe.
5. Pets – if you must bring your pets to the races, your pets MUST be on a leash. If you are caught without your pet on a leash, you will be told not to bring the pet back.
6. Please take care of your trash. There are bins around, use them.
7. If you are entering the pits, you MUST have a pit band on. If you are caught without one and cannot produce one for proof of entry, you will be escorted out. No excuses.
8. Anyone entering the pits must sign the waiver & release of liability. Any minors entering for the first time this season must have a parent/guardian with them to sign the minor release form to be kept on file.
9. Management reserves the right to deny or remove any individual without further notice.

RACERS/PIT CREW RULES:

1. All racers must sign a Waiver & Release of Liability. All minors must have a signed waiver signed by their parent/guardian before entering pits. The minor release form just needs filled out once per season to be kept on file. The waiver & release is signed weekly.
2. Pit pass must be worn on the wrist and visible at all times by everyone entering the pits.
3. All drivers are required to wear a full face helmet (2005 or newer snell approved), racing or track approved jacket, closed toe shoes, gloves, neck brace & long pants. Jeans or Firesuit preferred.
4. Your RACE AGE is determined as of January of the current year. You must race in the class your age falls into UNLESS approved by the track. It does not matter what class(es) you race elsewhere, approval for moving minors up is per track. Birth Certificates may be required.
5. All line ups will be posted on the line-up board in the pit area. The drivers are responsible for making it to the line up in time for their race. Karts must be in running order and ready to go.
6. Rough Driving. The flagman & corner workers will make those calls. It will be up to the flagman to send kart to the back or blag flag for the 1st call. Anyone called for rough driving a 2nd time in the same day, will be sent to the pits. Two offenses in the same day MAY result in a loss of points for that race.
7. During line up, the race on deck (the next race out) is permitted one racer and one additional person.
8. No karts are permitted to be driven in the pits. Please push. Once you reach the scale area, you MUST shut the kart off and push to pit, or place on stand and push. Warning is given at Drivers meeting, you will lose all points/monies/trophies for the race event if caught driving past scaling area.
9. NO kart maintenance/repair allowed on the track. To do so please make sure your kart is in the infield or the pits.
10. No one is permitted to enter the track area without an official's ok! NO ONE! If you step PAST the line-up chute on to the track without an official's ok, you will be told to leave the premises. If you approach the flagman, corner workers, scale tech, scoring table or line-up official in any type of derogatory manner, you will be told to leave the premises, you or the kart you represent will be eliminated for the day, forfeiting all points, monies, trophies.
11. Conduct by anyone at the track deemed inappropriate towards any race official and/or not complying with race official's instructions will be penalized.
12. The kart must have their race number CLEARLY displayed on all four panels (front, back, left and right sides). The numbers are to be no less than 6 inches in height, in contrasting colors. Please see the registration table for your weight sticker
13. Classes may be combined in the event of low kart count. However, awards will still be given to the class you represent.
14. Track Tech inspector and has binding and final say on all technical questions.
15. **OFFICIALS DECISIONS WILL BE FINAL.** Management reserves the right to deny entry or remove any individual without further notice.
